When?

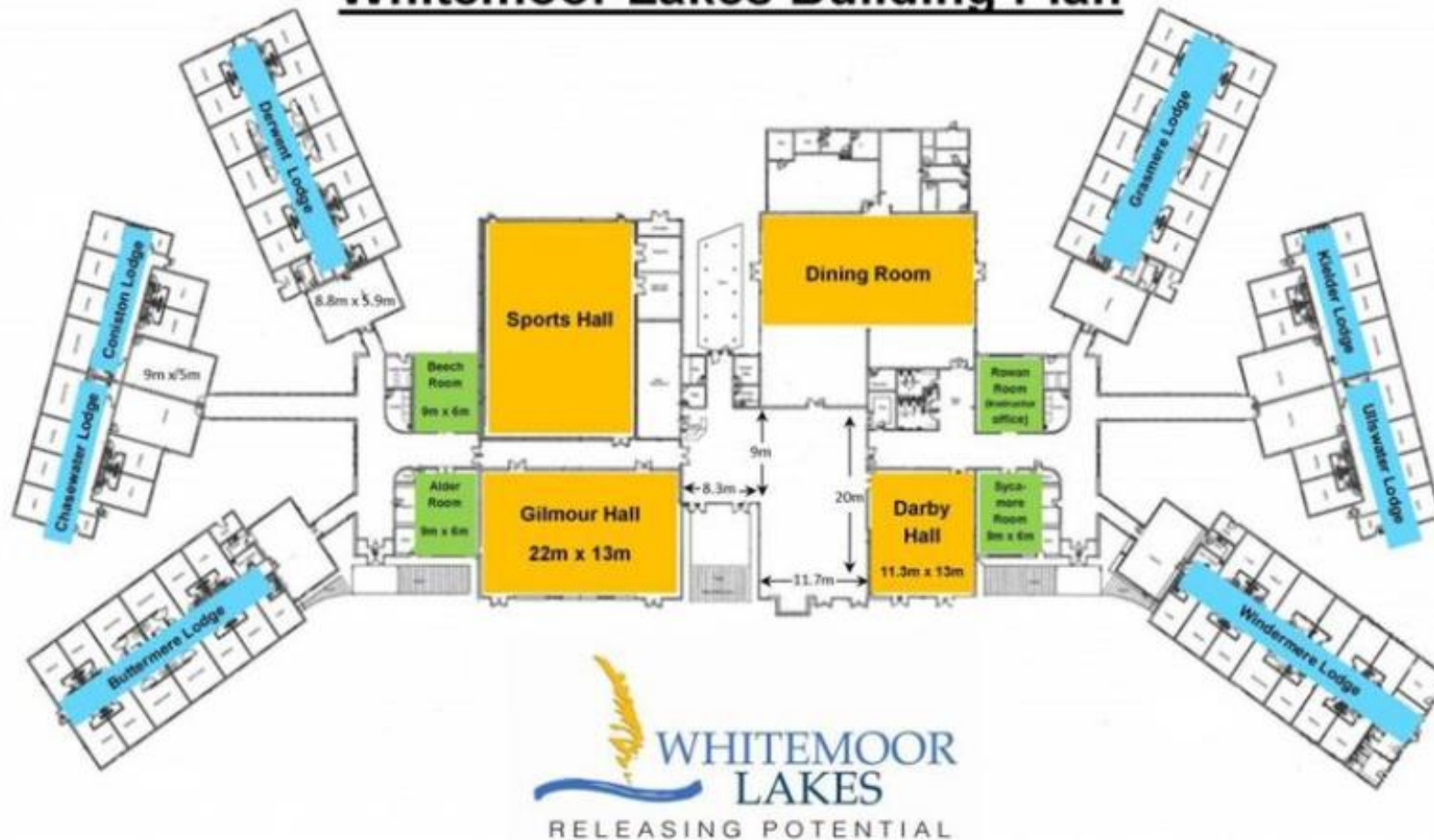
- Depart: Monday 18th May 2026

Whitemoor Lakes Building Plan





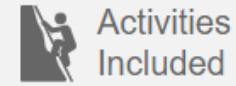
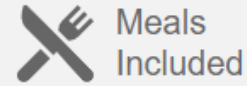
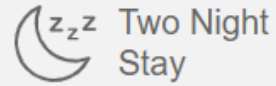
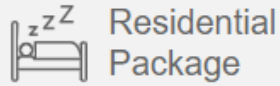
Who's Going?

Activities





Activity groups

- Children will be in mixed groups of 10 - 12 boys and girls for their activities.
- Each group is allocated a 'group liaison' - an adult who will look after the children, get them to the right activity at the right time and supervise meal times etc.
- Only children from our school will be in the activity groups.
- The dormitories (bedrooms) will be girls and boys separate.

Sleeping Arrangements

- Girls and Boys are in separate rooms
- Bedrooms have bunk beds or single beds and sleep 4 or 5 in a room. Every bedroom has its own en-suite bathroom.
- There will be children from other schools at Whitemoor Lakes, but not in the same lodges.
- Staff rooms are at the entrance to each of the lodges so teachers are accessible during the night if required.



Food

The centre provide all the food:

- Breakfast:-cereal, juice, cooked breakfast
- Lunch:-Jacket potato, cheese and beans (sandwich stations are available if the children need them)
- Dinner:-Sausage, mash and peas
- Vegetarian option available (water and fruit available throughout the day)
- If your child has any allergies, please let the teachers know and these will be taken into consideration.

Food

- During meal times, there will be designated tables for us to ensure we are able to dine as a group.
- We are able to accommodate a variety of dietary requirements, please let us know if you have any concerns around meal times.

Communications

- Children will not be allowed to bring mobile phones to Whitemoor Lakes.
- Staff members will have mobile phones with them in case of emergency.
- You will be informed of our arrival and expected return and a text sent out at the end of every day, letting you know how we have got on.
- We will also upload pictures to the school Facebook page every day.

Packing List

- You will need to pack:
- Water shoes (for water activities)
- At least 2 pairs of outdoor trainers (I will get wet so you need another pair for the other activities)
- 1 pair of indoor shoes
- Old jeans / tracksuit bottoms
- A couple of old long sleeved jumpers / sweatshirts / hooded tops
- Wet weather clothing including a waterproof coat!
- Warm weather clothing including a hat, sunglasses, sun cream (named)
- Plenty of clean underwear and socks!
- Plastic bags
- Pyjamas
- Toiletries
- A bath towel

Kit list

- Suitable Nightwear
- Underwear
- Trousers/leggings for activities (not jeans)
- Fleeces/sweatshirts for activities
- Long sleeved t-shirts (for activities where arms need to be covered – wear this)
- 1 set of clothes for the evening
- Pair of dry shoes for evening activities
- Waterproof jacket /cagoule / coat (wear this)

Kit List

- WET KIT - one old set of clothes including shoes (old black PE pumps are perfectly adequate) and a towel for canoeing
- Sun hat & sunscreen
- Wash bag (including soap, flannel, shampoo, toothbrush and toothpaste)
- One towel for showering
- Plastic drink bottle
- Labelled bag for wet and dirty clothing
- No aerosol sprays please
- All bedding is supplied

- The children can bring books/ comics/ note-pads/ top-trumps/ magnetic travel games etc. to help keep you entertained ...
- BUT REMEMBER NO mobile phones/iPods/ PSPs / MP3s etc

What to wear on the first day

- Please come in your own clothes ready to start your first activity.
- You will need your wet kit and towel for canoeing in a separate waterproof bag, with a spare carrier bag inside.
- Packed lunch in disposable packaging.

Payment

- Total Cost is £236 (coach will be paid by school)
- What to do next:
- Pay your deposit to secure your place - £20 deposit.
- The sooner we send the deposits the sooner we can choose our activities.
- The deposit is non-refundable.
- Payments paid in instalments throughout the year using SCOPAY
- The final payment needs to be paid by Monday 13th April 2026

Additional Information

- Children may bring a maximum of £5 - £10 in change in a labelled purse / wallet.
- There is a tuck shop selling sweets, drinks and souvenirs for children.
- Please pack labelled medication separately and hand in to Miss Maher on the first day.
- Inhalers must be carried at all times.
- No electronic equipment, staff will take plenty of photos.
