Week Beginning 18th May 2026



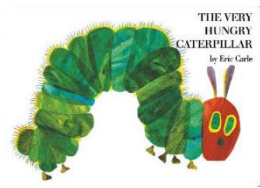
We cannot believe it is the last week before the half term holiday. We hope you have a lovely half term holiday and enjoy some wonderful sunshine (fingers crossed!) ☺

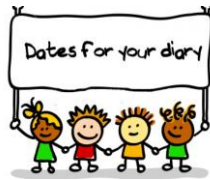
