Week Beginning 11th May 2026



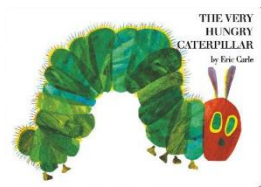
We hope you are all keeping well and have had a lovely weekend. Not long now until the next half term!

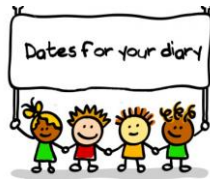
Afternoon Session 12:20-3:20
