Week Beginning 4th May 2026



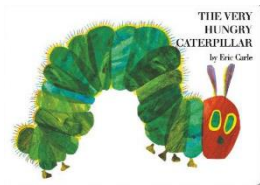
We hope you are all keeping well and have had a lovely weekend enjoying the sunshine. We hope you had a lovely long weekend and had a great Bank Holiday Monday.

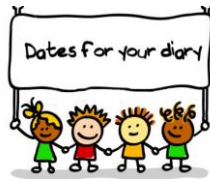
Afternoon Session 12:20-3:20
