Week Beginning 27th April 2026



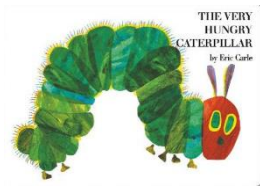
We hope you are all keeping well and have had a lovely weekend enjoying the sunshine.

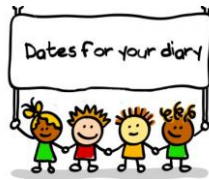
