Week Beginning 16th March 2026



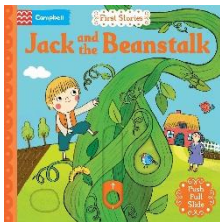
I hope you are all keeping well. Not long now until half term!

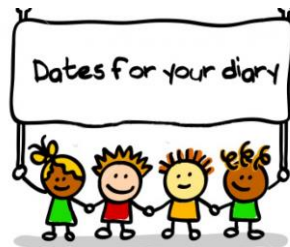
