Week Beginning 9th March 2026



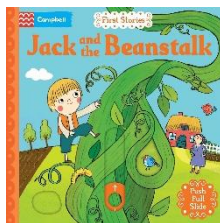
What lovely sunshine we had at the end of last week! We hope you are all keeping well and cannot believe how quick the half term is going.

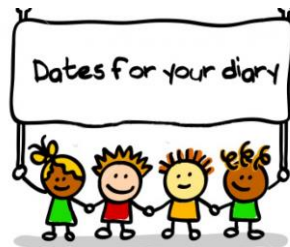
