Welcome back! We hope you've had a lovely half term! ☺

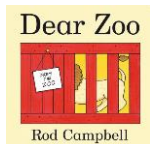
This week, we are going to start talking about 'Spring'. We will go on a spring walk around school.

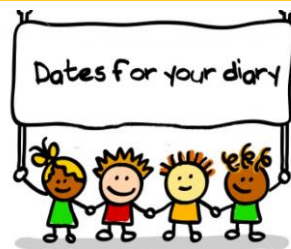
Afternoon Session 12:20-3:20
