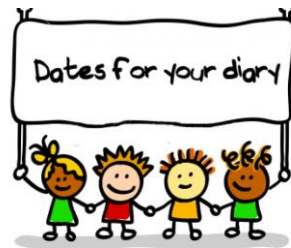
Morning Session 8:40-11:40
