In RE, this week we will continue our new unit, 'God our Father cares for us'. We will think about how our families are a gift from God. **With your child, talk about other gifts from God.**

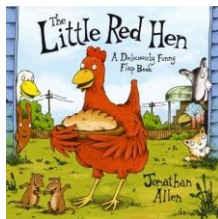

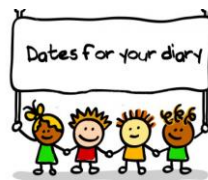
