In UTW this week, we will explore how the leaves begin to change colour at this time of year.

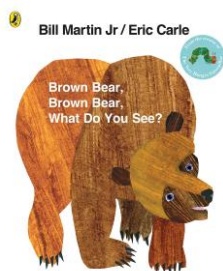

Focus words this week: Autumn, season, prayer, tree, kind

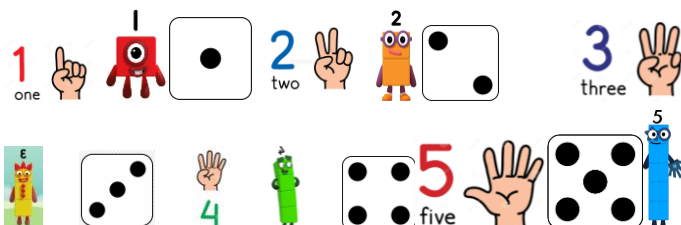
Talk about the words and what they mean. Can you use these words within a sentence throughout the week?

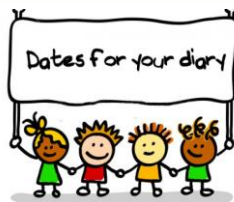
This week the children will:

- Continue to practise our counting daily, numbers up to 10, when we count the children in class.
- Explore roles within the home using the role play 'home corner' and the dolls house.
- Explore how the leaves begin to change at this time of year.
- Practice writing some pre-writing shapes and our names.
- Retell the story 'Brown Bear, Brown Bear'
- Use role play to help our memory of the story 'Brown Bear, Brown Bear'
- Recognising different colours.
- Counting to 5 on our fingers using songs such as five currant buns
- Practising using our manners, saying 'Yes please', and 'No thank you' during snack time.
- Practising taking turns and sharing during our guided play.
- We will be retelling the 'Creation story' and how God made the world.
- We will also continue to learn our daily prayers.
