Groups and phonics books are set accordingly to ability.



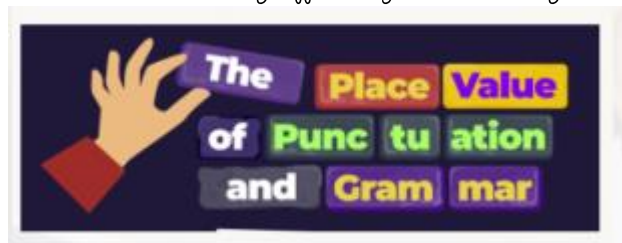
Religious Education (R.E.) -

Writing

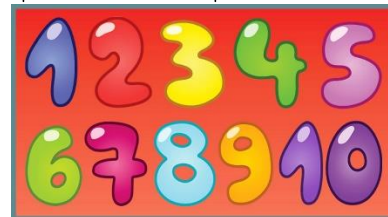
We will be starting off the year teaching:
