We have had a fun-filled first week back at school. The children have settled very well again, which is great. Please remember our maths parent workshop this Thursday 14th November: AM group 9-10.15 and PM group 12.30-1.45.

This week, we will continue to focus on our topic theme of 'Amazing Autumn', we will continue to explore the changes in the season. We will complete some leaf painting.

In Literacy we will continue the story 'Little Red Hen'. We will listen to the story. We will learn the story through repetition and actions, becoming more confident in our speaking. We will use a story map to learn this story. We will also talk about our favourite part of the story.

In Maths we will be learning all about patterns, recognising them and continuing a pattern.

In RE, this week we will continue our new unit, 'God our Father cares for us'. We will think about how our families are a gift from God. **With your child, talk about other gifts from God.**

In Understanding the World, we will learn about poppies and their significance to 'Remembrance Day'. We will also have our own special little prayer time, where we will be silent and think about the soldiers.

In expressive Arts & Design, we will complete some leaf painting.

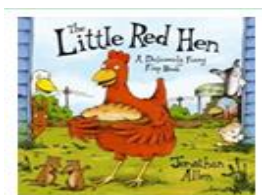
