We hope you all had a fun, enjoyable half term and are feeling well rested. We're glad to welcome you all back and our new pupils for a fun-filled and very busy halfterm. Please keep a look out for our parent focus for up to date news about different events taking place.

This week, we will begin to focus on our topic theme of 'Amazing Autumn', we will begin to explore the changes in the season and take an autumnal walk in our school grounds.

In Literacy we will begin the story 'Little Red Hen'. We will listen and watch the new story. We will begin learn the story through repetition and actions, becoming more confident in our speaking. We will use a story map to learn this story. We will also talk about the different characters in the story.

In Maths we will be learning all about positional language in front of and behind. We will also recap on our previous learning of in, on, under, beside and behind.

In RE, this week we will continue our new unit, 'God our Father cares for us'. We will think about how our families are a gift from God. **With your child, talk about other gifts from God.**

In Understanding the World, we will talk about the changes in the season and go for an autumnal walk around the school grounds, collecting autumn objects, such as leaves, sticks and conkers, which we will use our senses to explore them

In expressive Arts & Design, we will complete some leaf printing.

We will recap on setting the expectations of 'Ready, Respectful and Safe' so we will teach the children how to behave in the classroom areas, ensuring they are playing nicely with the other children and being safe.

Talk about the words and what they mean. Can you use these words within a sentence throughout the week?

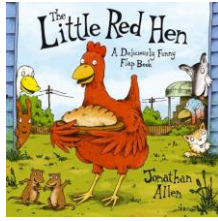

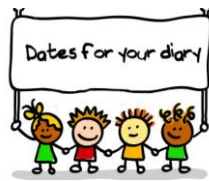


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This week the children will:
