In Understanding the World, we will talk about how we have changed since we were babies.

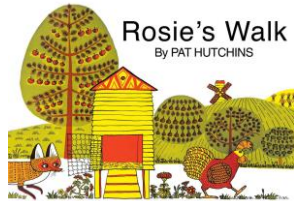
In expressive Arts & Design, we will make paper dol families.

The gates will be opened to allow parents to bring their child down to classroom and collect from the classroom. Please ensure, your child arrives and is collected promptly.

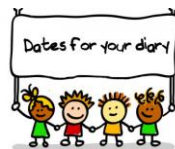
Nursery Staffing Arrangements
