This week, we will continue to focus on our topic theme of 'All About Me', we will begin to explore our five senses.

In Literacy we will be continue the story 'Rosie's Walk'. We will learn the story through repetition and actions, becoming more confident in our speaking. We will use a story map to learn this story.

In Maths we will be learning all about the number 2.

In RE, this week we will complete our new unit, 'Creation - God the Creator'. We will listen to the story of creation again and learn that God created the world. **With your child, talk about what we can see, hear and touch in God's world.**

In Understanding the World, we will talk about our five senses.

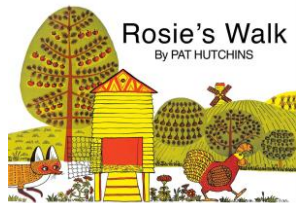
In expressive Arts & Design, we will use salt dough to make our own hand and footprints.

The gates will be opened to allow parents to bring their child down to classroom and collect from the classroom. Please ensure, your child arrives and is collected promptly.

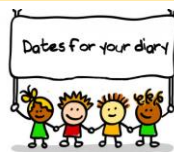
Nursery Staffing Arrangements
