Week Beginning: 7th October 2024

The children are continuing to develop their relationships with their peers and the different staff.

This week, we will continue to focus on our topic theme of 'All About Me', we will begin to explore what different jobs people have and we will talk about what the children would like to be when they grow up.

In Literacy we will be continue the story 'Fox's Socks'. We will learn the story through repetition and actions, becoming more confident in our speaking. We will use a story map to learn this story. We will try some mark making. We will perform our story.

In Maths we will be learning all about the number .

In RE, this week we will continue our new unit, 'Creation - God the Creator'. We will listen to the story of creation again and learn that God created the world. We will also learn how to make the 'Sign of the Cross' and how this a prayer. **With your child, talk about things you might pray about.**

In Understanding the World, we will talk about what the children would like to be when they grow up.

In expressive Arts & Design, we will use different materials to make our own faces.

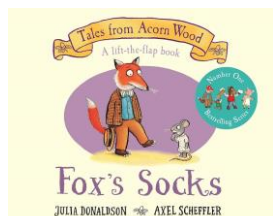

The gates will be opened to allow parents to bring their child down to classroom and collect from the classroom. Please ensure, your child arrives and is collected promptly.

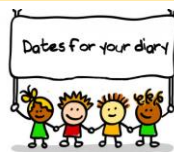
Nursery Staffing Arrangements
