The children are continuing to develop their relationships with their peers and the different staff.

This week, we will begin to focus on our topic theme of 'All About Me', we will begin to explore what makes us unique and special. We will talk about what we are each good at.

In Literacy we will begin the story 'Fox's Socks'. We will learn the story through repetition and actions, becoming more confident in our speaking. We will use a story map to learn this story. We will also try some mark making.

In Maths we will be learning all about the number 1.

In RE, this week we will continue our new unit, 'Creation - God the Creator'. We will listen to the story of creation again and learn that God created the world. We will also talk about the importance of saying

In Understanding the World, we will talk about what makes each of us unique, special and what we are good at.

In expressive Arts & Design, we will learn the song, 'If you're happy and you know it...'

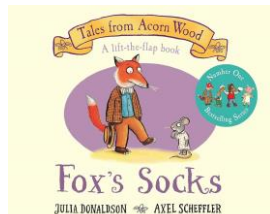

The gates will be opened to allow parents to bring their child down to classroom and collect from the classroom. Please ensure, your child arrives and is collected promptly.

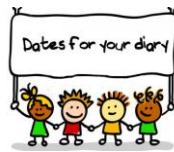
Nursery Staffing Arrangements
