In Literacy we will be introducing the story 'Brown Bear Brown Bear'. We will begin to learn the story through repetition and actions.

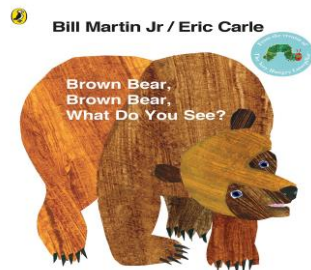
In Maths we will be introducing the colours, red, blue, yellow, green, orange and purple. We will go colour hunting inside and outside the classroom.

The gates will be opened to allow parents to bring their child down to classroom and collect from the classroom. Please ensure, your child arrives and is collected promptly.

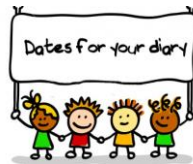
Nursery Staffing Arrangements
