



Reception Weekly Focus

Week Beginning: 7th April 2025

Our topic this half term is Growing.

Our caterpillars are almost ready to emerge and we hope this will be during the week so that we can release them before Easter.

We are completing our work on Handa's Surprise but we are also now writing using a new approach called drawing club. Drawing club uses a different text each week to teach children vocabulary and to stretch their imagination. They will be encouraged to come along to the club as part of their Literacy work, creating pictures, writing sentences as 'codes' and sharing their wonderful ideas.

In RE we begin our new topic of Holy Week by learning about the events that led to and include Good Friday. We will do this through role play and by listening to stories.

In maths we focus on making patterns and practising all the maths skills we have learnt this half term

Focus words this week: release, emerge, Easter, Good Friday, bonnet

Story Time

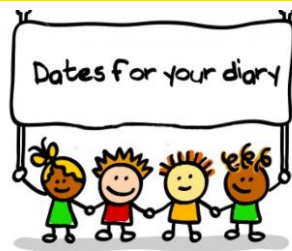
Reading books will be changed throughout the week.
