Reading books will be changed throughout the week.

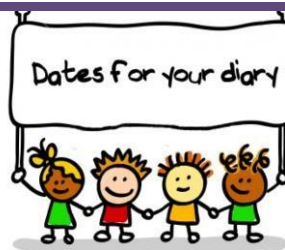
Library books can be changed each week in our cloakroom.

- Practising how to hold our pencils correctly for writing and drawing.
