



Nursery Weekly Focus

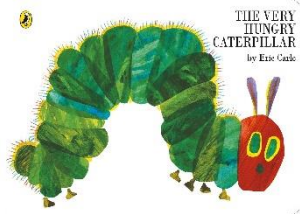
Week Beginning: 24th April 2023
