



Nursery Weekly Focus

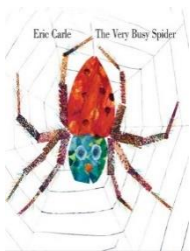
Week Beginning: 1st May 2023

Our focus story this week is The Very Busy Spider. We will be thinking of actions to help retell the story and sequencing the story using pictures. In maths we will be revisiting 2D shapes. The children will be drawing their own spiders using circles and rectangles and counting on the spiders legs.

Little Miss Muffet

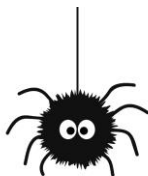
Sat on a tuffet,

Reading books will be changed on Monday.

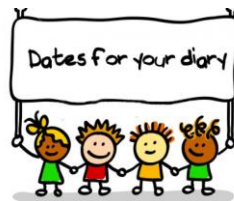
Please send your child's book bag into school each day with their reading books and planner. Please ensure the planner is signed to show that you have read with your child.
