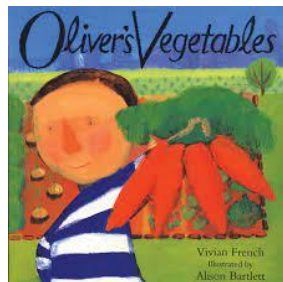
In RE, this week we will learn to say sorry and develop an understanding of right and wrong and revisiting what we have learned about Lent.

Reading books will be changed on Monday.

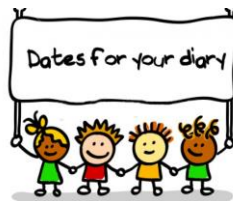

This week the children will:

- Buy fruit and vegetables in our new Fruit and Vegetable Shop role play area using 1p coins. Items in the shop this week will cost 4p which the children will make using four 1p coins.
- Taste a variety of fruits including apples, pineapple, strawberries, and bananas.
- Count using sorting fruit to match numerals and practise writing numerals 0-5.
- Discuss when we should say sorry and understand the difference between right and wrong.
- Revisit our learning about Lent and discuss the meaning of Lent.
- Continue to develop an understanding about 'Oliver's Vegetables', and practise our actions to retell the story.
- Innovate the story 'Oliver's Vegetables' and look at the 'Oliver's Fruit' book.
- Look at a variety of fruits, name them and talk about where they grow.
- Use fruit to paint and print.
- Plant cress seeds in cotton wool.
- Make a fruit skewer based on the fruit the children like.
