



Thank you to all those parents who supported their child to learn the nursery rhymes from last week. The children thoroughly enjoyed learning and singing the nursery rhymes.

The children are really looking forward to performing their nativity play for you and are excited for you to come and see.

This week, we will be continuing our focus, on the theme of 'Amazing Autumn'. We will: read and learn a new book 'Dear Santa'. This week we will read and learn our new story with a focus on the gifts and adjectives, words such as bouncy ball, messy finger paint and noisy trumpet. We will learn the story through actions, role play and different writing activities such as Santa letters and present labels. To reinforce the learning of Autumn, we will use tissue paper to make some leaf pictures. We are continuing to learn how to share, wait and take turns when working and playing together. We will be learning to recognise the number 9 and continue exploring different patterns. We will also learn what 1p looks like and use this to pay for our snack.

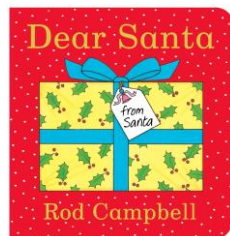
In RE, this week we will continue our new unit of work called 'Advent-Getting Ready. We will learn about the Advent wreath and how it is used to help count down the weeks to Christmas. We will also learn that during Advent we are getting ready and waiting for something special, Jesus' birth.

Focus words this week: kite, ball, tiger, finger, trumpet

Talk about the words and what they mean. Can you use these words within a sentence throughout the week?

Can you find this number in your house?

Can you show this amount using a resource?

Look at groups of objects. Is it 9 or not?

Roll dice, can you roll a 9? Encourage the children to try to spot 9 quickly without needing to count.

Home Readers

As you will have noticed, each of your children brought home a 'home reader' book. These are for you to read with your child and develop an enjoyment and excitement for reading.

You can change these books whenever you are ready too.

Morning parents: when you drop your child off, there is a bookcase in the cloakroom, this is where the home readers are kept, please, return and collect a new one when you need too.

Afternoon parents: At the end of the day, I will bring a selection of books up to the gate and if you need to change your book then, you will be able to. However, if it is easier, please put a note in the planner to say your child's book needs changing and we can do that for you.

This week the children will:

- Continue to practise our counting daily, numbers up to 16, when we count the children in class.
- Explore roles and jobs in a cafe using the role play 'Cafe'
- We will read the story 'Dear Santa'
- We will learn to retell the story through actions.
- We will create story maps to retell the story.
- We will design presents.
- We will practice writing through letters to Santa and present labels.
- We will use tissue paper to make some leaf pictures.
- We will recognise number 9 and recognise patterns.
- Practice writing some pre-writing shapes and our names.
- Practising using our manners, saying 'Yes please', and 'No thank you' during snack time.
- We will learn to use 1p to pay for our snack at snack time.
- Practising taking turns and sharing during our guided play.
- We will learn about and create Advent wreaths
- We will learn that we are waiting for Jesus' birth.
- We will also continue to learn our daily prayers.
