We will be learning to recognise the number 7 and continuing practising counting up to 5 objects. We will also learn what 1p looks like and use this to pay for our snack.

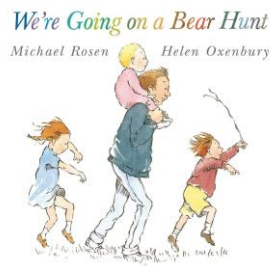
In RE, this week we will continue our new unit of work called 'God our Father care for us'. We will learn that families are a gift from God and the importance of saying sorry.

Focus words this week: **swishy, squelch, splash, swirling, gloomy**

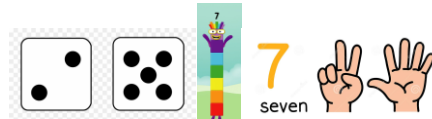
Talk about the words and what they mean. Can you use these words within a sentence throughout the week?

Home Readers

As you will have noticed, each of your children brought home a 'home reader' book. These are for you to read with your child and develop an enjoyment and excitement for reading.

You can change these books whenever you are ready too.

Morning parents: when you drop your child off, there is a bookcase in the cloakroom, this is where the home readers are kept, please, return and collect a new one when you need too.

Afternoon parents: At the end of the day, I will bring a selection of books up to the gate and if you need to change your book then, you will be able to. However, if it is easier, please put a note in the planner to say your child's book needs changing and we can do that for you.

This week the children will:

- Continue to practise our counting daily, numbers up to 16, when we count the children in class.
- Explore roles and jobs in a cafe using the role play 'Cafe'
- We will read the story 'We're going on a Bear Hunt'
- We will learn to retell the story through actions.
- We will retell the story through exploring the different settings, such as mud, grass and water.
- We will use paint to make acorn wreaths.
- We will do leaf people.
- We will recognise the number 7
- We will continue practising counting up to 5 objects.
- Practice writing some pre-writing shapes and our names.
- Practising using our manners, saying 'Yes please', and 'No thank you' during snack time.
- We will learn to use 1p to pay for our snack at snack time.
- Practising taking turns and sharing during our guided play.
- We will be talking about our families and recognise that they are a gift from God.
- We will learn the importance of saying sorry.
- We will also continue to learn our daily prayers.
