We will be starting a poem week this week. We will focus on 'Welly Boots' by Michael Rosen and taking part in lots of related activities.

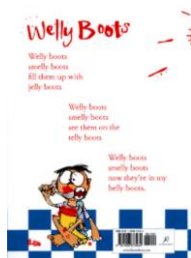
In RE we continue our topic of Easter. We will be thinking about different symbols of Easter and looking for other places that we see them.

**Focus words this week:** undergrowth, half, Double, burrow

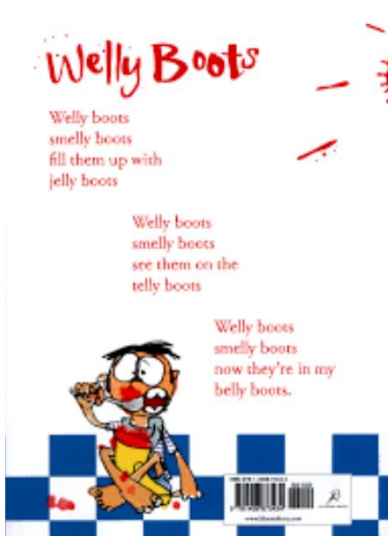
Talk about the words and what they mean. Can you use these words within a sentence throughout the week?

Welly Boots

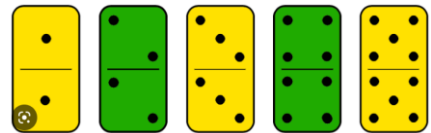


Rhyme of the Week: Welly Boots

### Story Time

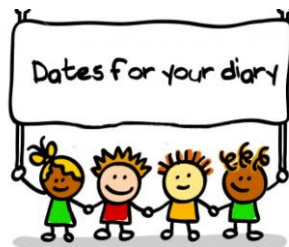
Reading books will be changed throughout the week.
