Week Beginning: 10th October 2022

We have begun our work on Goldilocks and the children have enjoyed listening to the story and describing the porridge. This week we will be making a story map and adding in actions to retell the story.

In maths we will be learning to count objects more carefully by making a teddy bear's picnic, sharing out the plates, cups and bowls.

In RE we continue our work on creation, learning about how God created the world.

Reading books will be changed throughout the week.

Come in and choose a book with your child!

This week the children will:

- Be making Autumn pictures using cotton buds and Autumn colours.
- Drawing a story map of Goldilocks.
- Counting using one number name for each objects.
- Making ABAB patterns in maths using different objects.
- Goldilocks pattern making in dry porridge, sand and other materials.
- Listen carefully, respond and join in with our new talk for writing story - Goldilocks
- Practise recognising and then writing our names (You may want to practise this at home too!)
- Continue to work hard to learn our set 1 phonic sounds and to form them correctly in their writing.
- Learning to blend sounds together to read.
- Practising how to hold our pencils correctly for writing and drawing.
- Go on an Autumn walk to identify the changes happening around us
- Purposely choosing colours for our art work.
- Threading using leaf outlines.
- Making leaf pictures with inspiration from the leaf man story.
