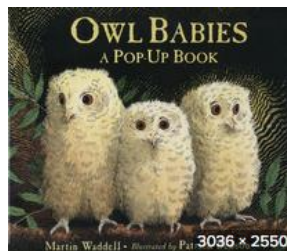
There are some ideas for further learning on our class page on the school website if you would like to do some work at home.

Focus words this week: Queen, Owlets, Pray, and Creation

Talk about the words and what they mean. Can you use these words within a sentence throughout the week?

Focus Story:

Owl Babies



Rhyme of the Week:

Chop Chop

Chop chop choppity chop,

Cut off the bottom and cut off the top

What there is left, put in the pot,

Chop chop choppity chop

(Ask your child to perform this with actions)

Maths Focus: Sorting objects by colour, shape and function



Provide your child with lots of different coloured objects. Use a timer to see how quickly they can sort the objects onto different coloured paper.

Story Time

Reading books will be changed throughout the week.

1000 story books will be changed on Mondays this half term.



This week the children will:

- Learn how to use the resources in our classroom.
- Continue to practise our daily routines such as signing in, writing their names, finding their pegs independently, putting their book bags in the correct place.
- Get changed for PE - we will be encouraging independence at school (You may want to start encouraging this at home to help them further)
- Counting and singing number rhymes each day.
- Listen carefully, respond and join in with our new talk for writing story - Owl Babies
- Talking about our families - please send in any family photos that you don't mind us using at school.
- Making pictures of ourselves and our friends using natural materials.
- Creating faces using playdough
- Using our lollipop characters to tell our 'Owl babies' story
- Practise recognising and then writing our names (You may want to practise this at home too!)
- Learn about our classroom rules and expectations.
- Practising how to hold our pencils correctly for writing and drawing.
