Guy Fawkes	A member of the group of Catholics involved in the failed Gunpowder Plot in 1605.
Traitor	A person who betrays someone or something.
Memorial	A statue or structure that remembers a person or event.
Treason	Crime of betraying your country, trying to kill monarch.
Gunpowder Plot	Failed attempt to assassinate King James I of England on 5 th November 1605.
Era/period	A long, important time in history.
