Subject Specific Vocabulary

Prehistoric	Time before written records.
Period / Age	A distinct / key time in history.
Nomad	A person who moves around. No permanent home.
Similarity & difference	Alike and different features: people, time, way of life, etc.
Artefact	An object made by a human that tells us history.
Neolithic	Later part of Stone Age. Weapons more polished.
Settlement	A place not lived in before where a community is made.
Monument	A statue/building/structure to honour a person or event.
Hunter-gatherer	Nomadic people who hunt and fish to survive.
