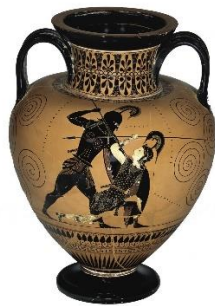

Subject Specific Vocabulary

Empire	Group of states or countries ruled by a single monarch.
City-state	Independent sovereign city with its own government.
Archaeologist	A person who studies human history through artefacts.
Democracy	A system of government formed by elected officials.
Kingdom	Country, state or territory ruled by a king or queen.
Artefact	An object made by a human that tells us how a society lived.
Legacy/achievement	Successful mark left by a group or individual on the world.
Philosopher	Someone who studies knowledge, nature and existence.
Conflict	A serious disagreement or argument.
Belief	To accept something is true without proof.
Influence	Have effect on character or behaviour of someone/something.
