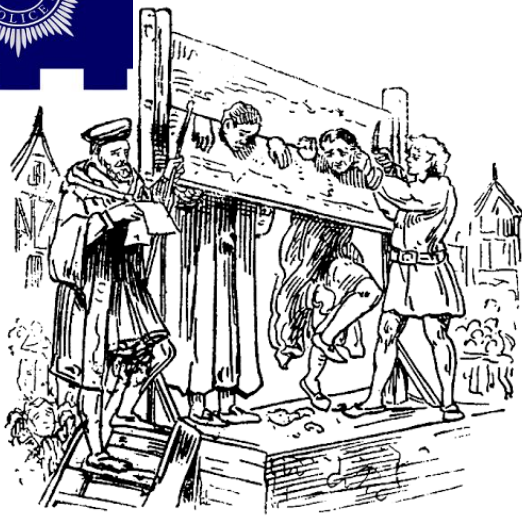

Subject Specific Vocabulary

Century	A period of 100 years.
Change	Make something or someone different.
Medieval	5 th to late 15 th Centuries starting with fall of the Roman Empire.
Source	A person/place/thing from which an item originates.
Justice	Treatment of someone that others consider fair.
Significance	Great or important.
Link	Relationship between two things where one affects the other.
Cause	The reason for something happening.
Consequence	Result/punishment from something negative happening.
Chronology	Things that happen one after the other in time.
Legacy	Mark left by individual or group on the world.
