Empire	Group of states or countries ruled by a single monarch.
Accomplishment	A successful achievement.
Dictator	A ruler with total power over a country, usually taken by force.
Historian	A person who studies or writes about the past.
Period	A long / important time in history.
Artefact	An object made by a human that tells us how a society lived.
Conquer	Overcome or take control of by military force.
Invasion	Unwelcome intrusion into another country or region by force.
Revolt	Take violent action against a government or ruler.
Belief	To accept something is true without proof.
Influence	Have effect on character or behaviour of someone/something.
