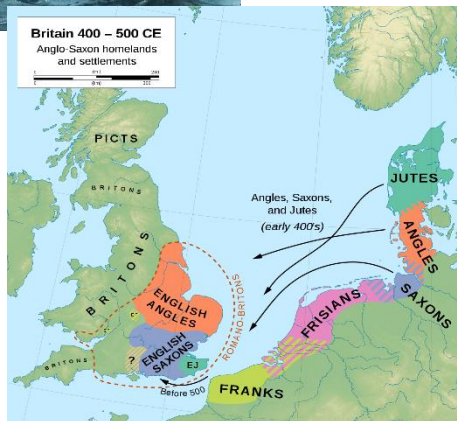

Subject Specific Vocabulary

Chronology	Arrangement of events in date order of when they happened.
Raid	A surprise attack on an enemy by an army.
Settlement	A place not lived in before where a community is made.
Migration	Movement from one place to another.
Hierarchy	Where members are ranked depending on their status.
Laws & Justice	Rules one must follow or they face severe punishment.
Artefact	An object made by a human that tells us how a society lived.
Invasion	An unwelcome intrusion into another country or region by force.
Battle	A sustained fight between large organised armed forces.
Kingdom	Country, state or territory ruled by a king or queen.
Significant	Great or important.
