Period/Age	A distinct / key time in history.
Dictator	A ruler with total power over a country, usually taken by force.
Prime Minister	The head of an elected government.
Source	A person/place/thing from which an item originates.
Significance	Great or important.
Cause	The reason for something happening.
Consequence	Result/punishment from something negative happening.
Compare	Look at how certain aspects have changed over time.
Battle	A sustained fight between large organised armed forces.
Decade	Ten years of time.
Invasion	Unwelcome intrusion into another country or region by force.
Surrender	Stop resisting an enemy. Give in to their authority.
