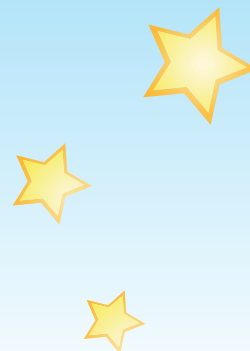


THE STRUCTURE OF A POEM JUST MEANS WHAT IT LOOKS LIKE ON THE PAGE – HOW IT IS SET OUT.

Structure can be created by using:

- Line length
- Verses
- Repetition
- Syllables
- Certain word types
- Specific words or phrases



Riddles

Riddle poems are set out so that the reader doesn't know what the subject of the poem is until they get to the end.

Here is the structure of a riddle poem

Opening question:

Who or what am I / is it?

Middle Clues:

It is furry



(Aim for at least 6)

It likes to go for a walk

Clue 3

Clue 4

Clue 5

Clue 6



End Question:

Do you know what it is?

Answer:

It is a dog!
