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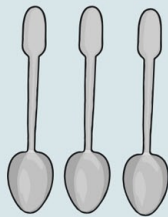
Thousand Island dip recipe

Ingredients



3 tablespoons mayonnaise

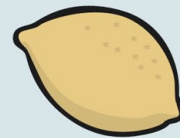
1 tablespoon tomato ketchup



½ teaspoon Worcestershire sauce



½ teaspoon lemon juice



Method

1. Mix the mayonnaise and tomato ketchup together until the sauce has turned pink in colour.

2. Add the Worcestershire sauce.

3. Gradually add the lemon juice to taste.
