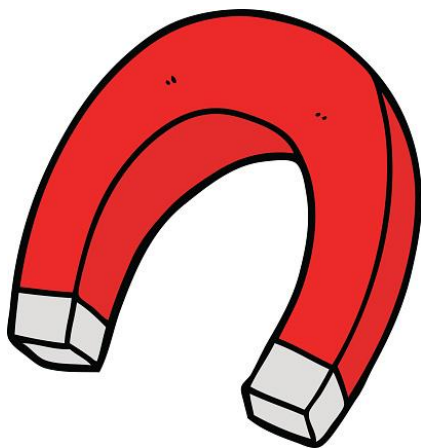

Subject Specific Vocabulary

forces	Pushes or pulls.
friction	A force that acts between two surfaces or objects that are moving, or trying to move, across each other.
surface	The top layer of something.
magnet	An object which produces a magnetic force that pulls certain objects towards it.
magnetic	Objects which are attracted to a magnet are magnetic.
poles	North and south poles are found at different ends of a magnet.
attract	Attraction is a force that pulls objects together.
repel	Repulsion is a force that pushes objects away.
