

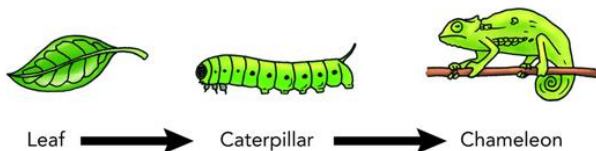

Subject Specific Vocabulary

habitat	The place a plant or animal lives is called a habitat.
ecosystems	An ecosystem is made up of all of the living and non-living things in an area.
carnivore	A carnivore is an animal that mostly eats other animals
omnivore	Omnivores are animals that eat both plants and other animals.
herbivore	A herbivore only eats plants such as vegetables, fruits, bulbs, grasses, roots, berries, and wood.
producer	A producer is the name given to a living thing that produces its own food, rather than consuming another living thing.
