

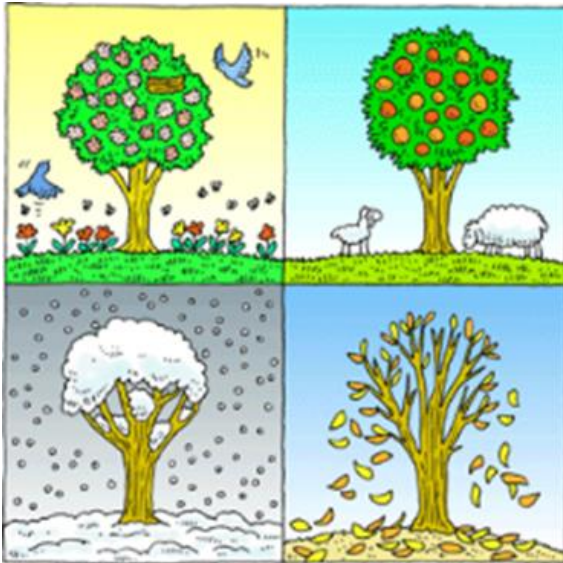

Subject Specific Vocabulary

seasons	There are four seasons each year, Autumn, Winter, Spring and Summer.
Autumn	In autumn, the weather begins to get colder. The leaves start to fall from the trees
Winter	In winter, the weather is much colder. Sometimes it is cold enough to freeze, leaving frost and ice on the ground
Spring	In Spring, the new leaves and buds begin to grow.
Summer	This is the warmest season. There are plenty of leaves on the trees and many plants are in flower.
weather	The weather includes the temperature outside, the wind direction and strength, as well as rain, cloud, snow and sun.
temperature	How hot or cold something is
