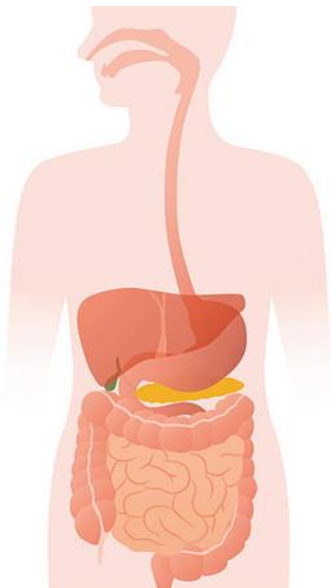

Subject Specific Vocabulary

digest	Break down food so it can be used by the body.
oesophagus	A tube which moves from from the mouth to the stomach.
stomach	An organ in the digestive system where food is broken down.
small intestine	Part if the intestine where nutrients are absorbed into the body.
large intestine	Part of the intestine where water is absorbed from food waste.
carnivore	An animal that feeds on other animals.
herbivore	An animal that eats plants.
omnivore	An animal that eats plants and animals.
producer	A plant that produces its own food.
predator	An animal that hunts and eats other animals.
prey	An animal that gets hunted and eaten by another animal.
