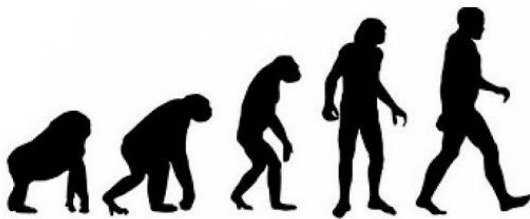

Subject Specific Vocabulary

offspring	The young animal or plant that is produced by the reproduction of that species.
inheritance	When characteristics are passed on to offspring from their parents.
characteristics	Features or qualities that are specific to a species.
variations	Differences between individuals within a species.
adaptation	A trait changing to increase the living thing's chance of survival.
habitat	An area or place where animals and plants can live.
evolution	Adaptation over a very long time.
environment	An environment contains many habitats and areas.
